



TSA-LA-GI Yacht Club Rules and regulations

Boat Registration

- All sailboats, dinghies, canoes and power boats must display a valid State of Oklahoma registration number and tax sticker. Boats not in compliance must be removed.
- All boat owners shall carry liability insurance on their craft. (Check with your homeowners policy.)

Harbor:

- No boat shall be launched without US Coast Guard approved personal safety devices, adequate anchors, bailing devices and appropriate safety equipment as described by the Federal and/or State Boating regulations.
- Recreational swimming or wading is not permitted from the docks or in the boating area. In this area, persons may enter the water only for boating purposes. TSA-LA-GI Yacht Club does not provide lifeguards nor does it provide any swimming beach in this area.
- All slip dock patrons must sign a Jackson Bay Marina, Inc. Dockage agreement prior to using that facility. See the Treasurer or Vice Commodore of Harbors.
- During periods of high water, transportation to and from the docks is the members' responsibility. The caretaker is not responsible for this activity.
- All yachts must use auxiliary power when navigating the harbor area south of the rigging dock/breakwater. Do not enter this area under sail.
- Effluent from portable toilets must not be dumped in the lake or in the clubs septic system (bath house).

Clubhouse:

- The clubhouse will be periodically stocked with toilet paper, towels, hand soap and cleaning supplies. If using the facility please clean up after yourself and leave it tidy for other members. Our caretaker and member work parties are responsible for major cleaning and maintenance.
- Each user shall clean up their own mess and place trash in the trash barrel. Food may not be left in the refrigerator longer than 36 hours and shall be identified by its owner. Personal property shall not be stored in the clubhouse.
- Young children should not be left unattended in the clubhouse.

Grounds:

- Boat trailers for those boats kept in the water shall be kept in the trailer lot. The trailers must display the owner's name. All boats stored on trailers and/or dry sailed must be movable by one person and they must have wheels or a trailer.
- All trailers must be maintained so they may be easily moved for lawn mowing or in the event of emergencies such as high water. It is the responsibility of the member to keep tires inflated and trailer in working order. It is a members responsibility to move their equipment during high water or other emergencies. The caretaker and other volunteers may move equipment when necessary.
- There is no parking in areas designated as picnic area or along the ramp roadway.
- Corps Rule 327-11 states all pets must be kept on a leash under 6 feet in length. Persons bringing pets into recreation areas shall be responsible for proper removal and disposal, in sanitary facilities, of all waste produced by these pets.
- Trash barrels are provided for your garbage. Help keep the Club grounds clean by utilizing these receptacles.

Camping:

- Public camping is permitted only on the North Point Campgrounds. These are 14 day maximum use campsites and no unattended equipment shall be located on a campsite for more than a 24 hour period. North Point Campground campers do not have bath house privileges. The bath house is for USE FEE MEMBERS ONLY.
- TSA-LA-GI Yacht Club/Jackson Bay Marina Inc.campsites are in the “USE FEE AREA” which is NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.
- All gray water shall be contained and disposed of in the proper manner. Do not pour it on the ground. Effluent from portable toilets must be disposed of in the same manner as required for boats as described under Harbors.
- All campers are expected to familiarize themselves with and follow the laws regulating camping on the Corps of Engineers Lakes (Title 36).

Safety suggestions:

- Boats left unattended at the rigging dock should be tied to the side away from the wind. Boats can suffer severe damage when winds shift. Watch the weather and continually check your boat.
- Jumping from boat to dock and running on the docks shall be avoided.
- Children should wear life jackets if they will be near the water or the docks.
- No fishing is allowed from the tie up docks, walkways, or any of the walkways of the slip docks.

High Water:

- Each member is responsible for the safety of their boat and equipment stored at the club. During periods of heavy rainfall, monitor the weather and be prepared to assist in moving boats and equipment.

Guests:

- Members are always welcome to bring guests to the club. Please insure your guests obey all the rules and regulations.
- As members of TSA-LA-GI Yacht Club, we pay Jackson Bay Marina Inc. for the use of their facilities. Fees are established by the board of directors. The facilities include the docks, shelters, boat hoist, mast hoist, picnic tables, parking lot, boat storage, trailer storage, club maintained camping area, clubhouse, bath house and marina maintained launching ramp. Separate fees are established for the use of the marina maintained launching ramp. Since this property is public access, all we can ask is the observance of the parking and no parking areas. Access to the water and shoreline cannot be restricted. The security fence and gate are to keep boats in not people out. The main gate is closed at 10:00 PM and opened at 6:00 AM. As a TSA-LA-GI member you cannot tell a fisherman or others they may not fish from the shorelines. Please be courteous and try not to create a confrontation that may result in a complaint to the Corps. If you have questions regarding our concession, please ask a TSA-LA-GI OFFICER.
